## **SPECIAL SCHOOL-BASED DECISION-MAKING COUNCIL MEETING**

Pursuant to KRS Chapter 61, notice is hereby given that on June 8th, 2020 the Chair of the Leestown School-Based Decision-Making Council (LMS SBDM Council) called a virtual SBDM meeting for **June 8th, 2020**.

The LMS SBDM Council will conduct a virtual meeting via video teleconference on Monday, June 8th, 2020 at 5:00 pm, EST. This will be a virtual meeting accessible through *The Leestown Way* YouTube Channel. The link for this meeting is [The Leestown Way](#)

Please be advised, due to the nationally proclaimed state of emergency and under a similar declaration by Governor Andy Beshear, it is not currently feasible for the SBDM to “provide meeting room conditions” in the face of COVID-19, a highly contagious virus that spreads between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Under these exceptional circumstances in which the Commonwealth of Kentucky is confronting a worldwide pandemic while nevertheless needing to accomplish critical public business, pursuant to KRS 61.840. Consequently, the LMS SBDM Council will not provide a primary physical location for public viewing and will proceed pursuant to KRS 61.826 with concessions outlined in the Attorney General’s Opinion OAG 20-05. Thus, the public can access the meeting via the live stream, but there will not be a physical location to participate in the meeting.
