- Targeted Support Planning Consultation:
- The Board of Education has approved Targeted Support Services for students not to exceed 15% of your building capacity. For Russell Cave this would be approximately 50 students.
- Must be supplemental – Beyond resource time and not to interfere with regular curriculum.
- 2 Hours Max a day
- 5 days a week
- Fayette County will provide transportation from 2:00 – 4:00
- Will begin on Oct 19th for 8 days
- Board has to approve school plan by Thursday, Oct 8th

Guidelines for Special Ed students:

- Based on their IEP
 - Only 2 days a week for 2 hrs per day
 - No OT or PT because these services are being offered
- EL ad GT will not be offered because these services are being offered
Healthy at School Guidelines will be followed
Classrooms will be deep cleaned
Students must bring their own supplies-students cannot share so the building will be safe.
Schools are not required to participate.

Recommendation from the LEAD Team:

- Bring back 2 groups of students from the SAT Group. These are kids that Mrs. Cron and Mr. Alex work with based on previous service history, behavior data, crises and parent request.
- Bring back Tier 3 groups of 1st and 2nd graders. 13 First and 14 2nd. These students will be selected based of their Literacy Assessment and MTSS.
- Would like to bring back ELL students but they can only be taught by ELL teachers and their schedules are full.
- The Tier 3 groups would be brought back 4 days a week.
