The Social Worker that we wanted to hire cannot get into the class she needs until January so she is ineligible at this time. Working on trying to get her hired as a long term sub.
- Targeted Services: Originally planned for 8 days. Since the Board voted to extend virtual learning until the second semester, we will continue with targeted instruction and hopefully add students. We could add 20 more. We have already added Pre-School and will continue with SPED services. Considering adding an additional day. Have asked the teachers involved in the targeted services to discuss if they want to continue. Will get back with them this week.
