Culture and Climate

PBIS school-wide data shared including office discipline referrals, in-school and out-of-school suspension data.

School Improvement Planning:

Review of the overall Winter MAP Math and Reading data including current projected proficiency and growth within each grade level. The data indicated celebrations for 7th grade math with 14% novice and the positive impact of the co-teaching initiative in 6th and 7th grades followed by 8th grade in 2019-20. 8th

grade math is a target area, however the implementation of Envision curriculum and personnel changes are considerable outlining factors. In reading, the average 6th grader increased five (5) points on RIT score and out-performed the rest of the district, while 8th grade is on track. The year-to-year comparison in math indicated higher proficient and distinguished level from last year to this year based upon the implementation of Envision curriculum.
