COMMITTEE REPORT:

Curriculum and Instruction:

Today was the first day for Targeted Services, bringing students in four days a week. The students are assigned to a group and stay in the same room. Teachers rotate through in 30 minutes sessions - checking in / navigating online platforms like Imagine Learning, Zoom, and Canvas); reading; math; encore - music, stem, PE, drama

POLICY / BY-LAW REVIEW:
