

Lexington Traditional SBDM Meeting Minutes

October 13, 2020

SBDM Agenda was reviewed and approved by T. Sanford with a second from S. Kelly. Minutes were reviewed and approved by committee with a motion from L. Patton and a second from T. Sanford.

L. Caudill shared good news of LTMS from the committee. Participation rates are OK for the most part. We have had about a 40% increase in participation. It has been fun to watch as L. Caudill does walk-throughs. Some normal continued in sports. It's good to see kids do something normal. Healthy at school team has had a lot of great discussions to get our kids back in school.

C. Goble was invited to the meeting to speak on needs for the music department. New instruments are needed. They are at the point where they can't be fixed. C. Goble will let the committee know of final numbers for what the music department is asking for. C. Globe left the meeting.

L. Caudill went over the final SBDM training to make sure everyone has been trained. Those who haven't been trained were instructed to sign up. This is the final SBDM training available.

L. Caudill presented MAP Testing info. We are close to testing all of our kids. After the 16th we will have results to present. Student data achievement was reviewed with the committee. We have hit an achievement goal where 80% of students have set a goal. We are at 84%. 61% of students have had a check-in. L. Caudill will encourage teachers to set a goal for teachers to record their checkins by the 27th to have what is now 61%, moved to 80%. L. Caudill also shared that we have learned the pacing of our units has to get better.

L. Caudill presented the Targeted Services Plan with the committee. No comments were offered. Changes that Mr. Caudill noted will be made today. L. Caudill mentioned the Hybrid Plan review is still in the works. The plan is due on the 23rd. Healthy at school committee will meet tomorrow. There will be a special called meeting on Tuesday, October 20th at 5:30 pm to go over the draft plan. L. Caudill is asking for increases overall on our MAP Goal Settings. L. Caudill shared the Big Rocks Review with the committee and there was no comment.

The budget was presented to the committee by L. Caudill. We are a quarter of the way through the school year. Things will change as soon as teachers get back into the building. From the district's Day 4 staffing report, if we were in school, we would have lost 1RA, 2 teachers and a .5 position classified (Attendance Clerk). If no increase is seen in the student population, these are the cuts that we will be looking at. We were held harmless due to the state that we are in. S. Kelly asked were those numbers impacted because of the VLA students? L. Caudill says yes and no and elaborated.

Healthy committee is viable and working on the return of school. The committee agreed to move the last two items on the agenda to the special called mtg on the 20th. Personnel will be added on the agenda. Meeting is adjourned with a motion from T. Sanford and a second from L. Patton at 7:10pm.
