### NEW BUSINESS

- Summer Ignite Proposal - funding by the federal government Ms. Moorhead and Mr. Harvey are running the program and are presenting tonight. This is the link to the proposal. Here are some of the highlights.
- Not traditional summer school, it is more of a camp and has more of a fun feel.
- We can take 380 students for the first session and 200 for the second session but that is still not all of our students so we need to prioritize how we will accept our students.
- Top priority is failing a course, not a grade level, sped, ELL, attendance issues
- We are staffed 20:1 student to staff ratio.
- We lowered the ratio a little bit for smaller groups for some students and for extra coverage for teachers that might not be able to come each day.
- the district does have guidelines we have to stick too. It has to be in person, robust, rigorous, engaging, deeper learning, and social emotional well being.
- District is paying for transportation
- Schedule will look like: Breakfast, two morning sessions, lunch then two afternoon sessions. Students should be able to choose what they take. If they have failed classes they will have to take one or two of those classes but still get to take the fun classes.
- We have categories like grade recovery, arts and sciences and physical activity
- Some ideas are cooking classes, global cultures, arts and crafts, PE, Ag Science, Gardening, drama, puzzles, wilderness survival, competitions, quiet things, science

- **2021-22 Staffing Proposal (see attachment)** staffing in March is based on 98% of enrollment
- they looked at a 3 year average instead of just looking at this year since this was a weird year
- we are staffed for 1151 students that is a little lower than this year so we are going from 38.5 to 38 core teachers. Then from 16.5 to 16 elective. This is one full teacher. Clerical is the same. SAFE is staffed by district. Everything else is the same.
- Proposal is to maintain what we have right now. Same 7 period day right now.Changes: 8.1 SS and .9 purchased by the school. Losing one MSD teacher. .5 business and marketing funded by school. After the changes shown in the staffing attachment, we would owe \$3018. No questions asked. Clary first and Stallmith second. Motion approved.
