

HARRISON ELEMENTARY SBDM School Council Policy

The policy topic description is a procedure for developing the School Improvement Plan (SIP) that involves all committees presenting goals to the whole faculty with final approval from SBDM.

- Committees as directed by SBDM collect key findings from testing, attendance data, discipline report, parents, volunteers, Title I and FRC surveys, student achievement notebooks, S.A.T. data and other pertinent data. Reviews of Impact and Implementation as SBDM directed by SIP.
- Present data to faculty for discussion.
- The SIP committee and leadership team will develop activities to be reviewed by committees.
- Report back to the committees for input.
- Report progress to SBDM, Principal, PSA or SIP Chair.
- SBDM develops a budget for the plan.
- Policy and Procedures Committee compiles the plan. PSA or an administrator will chair the committee.
- Professional Development Committee will develop professional development activities to support the plan.
- Present SIP and PD Pan to faculty for approval.
- The Committee Chair or representative will present the SIP plan to SBDM for approval.
- Once approved by SBDM, the plan will be submitted to _____ and other agencies as required.
