TECHNOLOGY USE

The school shall utilize technology in a manner consistent with local school board policy and state laws and regulations. BMS shall appraise all technology type programs in a manner that is consistent with local school board policy. The following guidelines shall be implemented regarding technology:

1. Sustained analysis of whether the technology type programs are contributing adequately to helping all our students meet state standards.
2. Systematic work to improve programs so to meet state standards for all students within the timetable set by the Kentucky Board of Education for reaching proficiency by 2014.
3. Ongoing monitoring and evaluation of the implementation and impact of programs.
4. Students and staff will comply with Beaumont's Electronic Resources Acceptable Use Policy and Fayette County Public School's Acceptable Use Policy.
5. When a certified staff member resigns, retires, or for another reason leaves his/her position at Beaumont (including transfers to other schools), all hardware and software are to remain at Beaumont for reallocation as determined by STC, microcomputer specialist, administration and/or technology committee.
