- Mills - PBIS took 110 students kids to the Legends game and had a great time and were SO GOOD!
- Girls Lacrosse ranked 25th in the state. Last time Diaz checked boys were in the top 5.

- **MASTER SCHEDULE**

- Shawn Hinds is here to talk about our master schedule. The master schedule is a living document that is always undergoing changes as we work.
- Will start assigning teachers in the next few days
- Main goal is purity in academies.
- We take what we project from our current existing schedule and project forward to next year. This gives us a template to work with.
- Every department will gain positions next year due to our growth.
- Diaz addressed the three levels of subjects being offered.
- AP classes are placed based on their population in a way that we can be strategic to keep academy specific students pure.
- It's a massive puzzle and the work is never done here.
- Diaz wants the best class sizes as possible and the purity is a big goal as well.
- Will be able to use Title II money to pay for AP training for all the subjects.
- Capped at 31 but most classes will just hit the upper 20's. We are staffed at 31-1.
- Talked about the possibility of specialized programs in every academy.
- Jeff is observing from ECU and working on his MAT.

**V. Review of Committee Meetings - no committees met due to spring break but Diaz discusses issues pertaining to specific committees.**

**1. Budget**

- Diaz is sharing the projected Section 6 budget. Money is very low because it works on last years ADA (983). We will come in at about 1400 kids for next year and money will be allocated once we get that number.
- Technology money was cut by almost 80%. Pretty much everything was cut.
- Most of the money has been requested out of the Perkins funds.
- There might be an error in the numbers for Social Studies.
- Diaz also addressed the current Section 6 budget and contingency. Will need 250 chromebooks at \$238. \$13,000 will be taken out of that contingency for those.
- Retro fitting the courtroom.

**2. Curriculum and Instruction**

- Diaz reviewed ACT score results. Went over a sample form that the students received with their information on it.
- Collaborating with the cinematography class to make a video to help students with resources to increase some of these scores.
- April got the scores back. Juniors are back except for accommodations. Sophomores are back except for accommodations. April reviewed the data for each type and what all the composite and benchmark scores are.
