PROGRAM APPRAISAL NEEDS ASSESSMENT

- School staff and stakeholders analysis our state testing data and other school data as necessary to discover the extent to which our students are meeting state standards and our programs are proving effective, including but not limited to our categorical programs.

- Program review committee review of the following programs: Arts/Humanities, Practical Living/Career Studies, Writing, World Languages, and the Primary Program/K-3 (elementary only) and/or others required by the state of Kentucky.
- A revision of our School Improvement Plan based on our needs assessment data for that year. The Plan will set goals, address causes, and make indicated changes to programs to help move our students to state standards according to the timetable established by the Kentucky Board of Education.

We will implement this process to address the effectiveness of all our programs and the resulting plans for improvement will be monitored by the council.
