 - a. EPES: Principal reviewed EPES budget to date. There is \$6,038.76 in general fund. School is anticipating rental income from extended school services.
 - b. MUNIS: There is a \$224 amount that is coming out of principal’s office, it is taken out of the contingency money. There is still \$702.08 left in classified overscheduled. Will use for safe crisis management training. Northern regular instruction 0120 certified salary, there is \$660 left. We will be using that money to pay for special education substitutes. There is 29,802.91 left in the budget. In regular instruction there is \$610, there is currently \$3,382.62, that money will go up to the contingency under principal’s office and transfer all of that down to general supplies.
