Progress Monitoring of Student Achievement

The principal, leadership team, and other staff members commit to continuous review of students' progress through:

1. Regular administration of assessments and data analysis of assessment results to differentiate instruction.
2. Communicating assessment results to parents and providing suggestions for extensions of student learning at home.
3. Analyzing student participation in extracurricular programs and the impact of these programs on student achievement.
4. Assigning students to Saturday School enrichment/tutoring as indicated by assessment results or teacher observations.

Recognition of Student Achievement

At the end of each nine-week reporting period a school-wide assemble will be scheduled to recognize student achievement non-academic indicators that impact student achievement including:

1. A and AB Honor Roll for intermediate students
2. Reaching Reading Counts Goals
3. Good Citizenship (based on completion of homework, in-class assignments, effort, leadership, and behavior)
4. Perfect Attendance
