SPECIAL SCHOOL-BASED DECISION MAKING COUNCIL MEETING

Pursuant to KRS Chapter 61, notice is hereby given that on April 24, 2020 the Chair, of the Morton Middle School Based Decision-Making Council (Morton SBDM Council) called a “special meeting” of the Morton SBDM Council for Wednesday, April 28, 2020 at 4:00 PM, EST at 1225 Tates Creek Road, Lexington, KY 40502

The Morton SBDM Council will conduct a virtual meeting via video teleconference on Wednesday, April 28, 2020 at 4:00 PM, EST. This will be a virtual meeting accessible through Zoom, meeting ID #987-1031-3749

Please be advised, due to the nationally proclaimed state of emergency and under a similar declaration by Governor Andy Beshear, it is not currently feasible for the SBDM to “provide meeting room conditions” in the face of COVID-19, a highly contagious virus that spreads between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Under these exceptional circumstances in which the Commonwealth of Kentucky is confronting a worldwide pandemic while nevertheless needing to accomplish critical public business, pursuant to KRS 61.840. Consequently, the Morton SBDM Council will not provide a primary physical location for public viewing and will proceed pursuant to KRS 61.826 with concessions outlined in the Attorney General’s Opinion OAG 20-05. Thus, the public can access the meeting via the live stream, but there will not be a physical location to participate in the meeting.
