- 1. REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM 8-13-18 AND 8-28-18 MEETINGS**
Corrections were made to the 8-13-18 minutes. Jane Brannon moved that the minutes be approved as amended. Ms. Runyon seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- 2. ADDITIONS TO CURRENT AGENDA**
There were no additions to the agenda.

- 3. PUBLIC COMMENT**
There was no public comment.

- 4. CLUB SOCCER PROPOSAL**
Tony Hicks presented a proposal for a girls' club soccer team at Morton. After the presentation and discussion by council members, it was established that the soccer team would not be a club team, sponsored by Morton, but rather a team organized on its own. Therefore, the agenda item was taken off the table.

- 5. CURRENT STAFFING UPDATE**

- 6. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL**
Jane Brannon moved to give Ms. Runyon the authority to sign off as the SBDM Council on PD professional leave paperwork. Sara Schuer seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

- 7. SBDM POLICIES UPDATE REVIEW**

8. MAP TESTING

MAP testing has begun. ELA MAP testing will end Tuesday, September 11th. Math MAP testing will begin Wednesday, September 12th.

9. ESS PROPOSAL

Ms. Dixon presented some information regarding the ESS proposal for the 2018-2019 school year. New information presented was that the ESS proposal no longer needs to be voted on and approved by the SBDM council. The proposal only needs to be discussed at the SBDM meeting, and signed by both the principal and the ESS coordinator. This year ESS will be meet on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. The Tuesday and Thursday sessions will be run by Ms. Crystal Dixon (math) and Mrs. Sheila Dixon (ELA). The Wednesday sessions will be run by Mrs. Carter (math).

10. YANKEE CANDLE SALES UPDATE

Totals in the building sales are currently at \$13,000. Online sales are at \$5,800. Morton receives 40% of the sales. The goal for this year is \$30,000.

11. SCIF YEAR-TO-DATE BUDGET PROPOSAL

The budget was distributed and reviewed.

12. OTHER

- Ms. Randolph asked about other fundraisers in the school. Normally only one whole school fundraiser is done during the school year. If there is a team or a group who wants to do its own fundraiser, it does not need to be approved through the PTSA. However, there may be some other approvals that will be needed.
- Mrs. Lawson announced that the police department is willing to come to the school to do emergency type training for staff if the school is interested.
