**1. REVIEW & APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM NOVEMBER 12, 2018 MEETING**

After correcting the minutes Crystal Dixon moved to approve them as amended. Amy Lawson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**3. PUBLIC COMMENT**

**4. CSIP 2018-2019**

Karen Ziegler and Lisa Owens presented a draft report of phase III for CSIP. The main goal is to raise the proficiency level and to lower the novice level. This is a working document. The principal's chief reviews the document and will return it for amendments by December 15, 2018 before the final submission. Rubin Jones moved to approve the goals and objectives of the report. Allie O'Donnell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**5. CARRY FORWARD FUNDS**

Carry forward funds were received. There was discussion of the need for a second period elective. An 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher would need to be able to do this, with a stipend of \$3.500 for teaching the elective course. This teacher would also need to complete an extra hour of planning, either before or after school. A Dave Ramsey financial course was donated to the school, which could be used for the elective course. Crystal Dixon moved that an elective for second period be created. Whitney Dixon seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**6. STAFFING**

The school is still in need of a para educator and an interventionist. An interview for the interventionist position will be December 15, 2018. There was discussion of dividing the available 1.0 para position, to a 0.8 position, and the 0.2 position would be a sub position. Scott Cahill moved that the 0.8 para position remain the same, and a 0.2 position be offered as a sub position for the moment. Crystal Dixon seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**7. MAP TESTING**

Karen Ziegler and Lisa Owen reported that MAP Reading is finishing. There seems to be a lot of growth with the MAP scores. Math MAP testing will begin immediately after the Winter Break. There is much excitement among the students about the growth in MAP scores, and teachers are giving incentives for growth.

**8. FIELD TRIPS**

District Board will no longer allow schools to go to amusement parks Monday-Friday. Groups who perform cannot go on rides until after 4:00pm. Therefore, teams will have to adjust these types of field trips.

**9. SCIF YEAR TO DATE BUDGET REPORT**

Budget report was distributed and reviewed. There were no questions.
