

# Birthday Book Club



opportunity to donate a book to the school library in honor of your child's birthday. The book your child chooses will have a sticker placed inside the front cover stating that the book was donated by your child in honor of his/her birthday.

**How does it benefit Rosa Parks Elementary?** The RPE library typically receives 250-300 new hardback books each year through Birthday Book Club donations. Participation is optional.

**How does it work?** There is a Birthday Book Club cart in the library full of new hardback books students can donate to the library during their birthday month (half-birthdays for summer birthdays). During regular library time, kids who have signed up for BBC will be allowed to choose a book from the cart and put their name on a sticker to be placed inside the front cover. Your child will be the first person to check out their chosen book. Once returned to the library, the book will be placed into circulation for anyone to enjoy. BBC kids also receive a birthday / thank you card containing a coupon for a special treat from a local vendor (ice cream, frozen yogurt, etc).

**How much does it cost?** \$15

**How do I sign up?** Include your child(ren)'s birthday info on the PTA membership form and include \$15 payment per book.
