Student Achievement Data:

A. Academic (achievement and growth)

- Schools get a 5 star rating now with new system (we are 2 star)
- Elementary proficiency, separate academic indicator, growth scores included
- Star rating is states label
- Federal rating is TSI and CSI- Arlington was neither this year
- Proficiency and separate academic indicator still in low range
- Accountability weights
- Achievement gaps looked at for KPREP/ overall cut scores
- Growth on KPREP compared to previous year
- MAP data reports per grade level

B. Attendance

- September 95.54% students
- September 96% staff
- We are hitting district standard

C. In/ out of school Suspension

- September behavior data shared 0-1 office referrals 272 students, 2-5 referrals 4 students, 6 or more referrals 0 students
- Fight 4 students / 2 dangerous instruments
- Third grade has highest referrals - end of the day is most prevalent time
- 6 days in school suspension September/ mainly sped schools
- 1 out of school suspension September/ non-sped student
- 98.6% no referrals
- % grade levels 3 or less office referrals
