A. Academic (achievement and growth)

- Growth from previous year to this year shows improvements

C. In/ out of school Suspension

- Decrease in December referrals from November
- 3rd grade most referrals then 1st & 4th
- Fight (student other)
- 10 students in August to December SAFE 9 days total per 100, avg. 3
- Out of school suspension August to December 6 days total
- White students are the most with out of school suspension, African American, Hispanic
- Low SES highest
- Non-sped/sped difference of 1
- 95% no referrals
- Decrease from october to november
- No in out of school suspension in December
