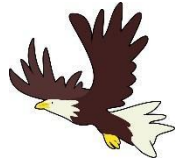


# Arlington Elementary Advisory Committee Minutes

## Student Achievement Data:

### A. Academic (achievement and growth)

- Map Testing starts next week Sept. 28 – 30
- Sending information to parents that it is important that students take the test on their own
- MAP Testing is to provide a benchmark (diagnostic) as to where students are, given 3 times a year: fall, winter, spring
- Reported scores will be shared with parents at a later date

## Budget:

- PD PLAN:
  - Teachers have to do 24 hours of PD each year

- Hiring additional instructional para for hybrid mode

### **CSIP:**

- What is CSIP?
- Based on state test scores for consistency
- Not changing anything from last year's CSIP due to no KPREP scores from 19-20
  - Sharing document in Nov./Dec. meeting
- If ESSA provides state testing waiver, KY may waive state testing
  - Should know more this winter
  - If testing, no SS pilot for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

### **Family Engagement:**

- 4 family activates planned in Fall for Title 1 (virtually, even if hybrid)
  - More information coming in October

### **Support Team Progress Update:**

- No information about a district team yet
- Cambridge is Arlington's support team with professional learning planned throughout school year

### **New Business:**

- Hybrid planning
  - Hope to make a decision on Sept. 28 about virtual/hybrid
  - Students will need to have temperature taken before entering building
  - There will be a holding place for students who have temperatures while waiting on pick-up
- A/B Days – Student numbers are cut in half
  - One group Monday and Tuesday, Wednesday virtual for cleaning, Thursday and Friday second group
- Working on template for family communication, consistent between schools

- Hybrid changes so far: (CAN CHANGE)
  - 6 feet apart, still need masks, even at recess
  - Students not allowed on play equipment
  - 1 lunch choice
  - Students are able to walk around building when accompanied by an adult if cleaning takes place
  - No locker / cubby use at this time
- Every school will have a dashboard on school website where parents can see covid cases in building
- Parents will have 24 hours to alert child's school to positive covid case
