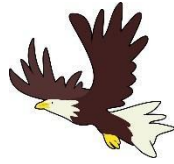


# **Arlington Elementary Advisory Committee Minutes**

### **a. Academic (Achievement and Growth) Winter MAP:**

- i.** Reminder - Testing environments and times were not able to be controlled by the school as they have in the past
- ii.** Kindergarten:
  - 1.** Math – 61% average or above
    - a.** Lowest performance area: Numbers and Operations
  - 2.** Reading – 61% average or above
    - a.** Lowest performance area: Reading Foundational Skills
- iii.** First Grade:
  - 1.** Math – 59% average or above
    - a.** Lowest performance area: Measurement and Data
  - 2.** Reading – 52% average or above
    - a.** Lowest performance area: Reading Foundational Skills
- iv.** Second Grade:
  - 1.** Math – 19% average or above

- a. Lowest performance area: Numbers and Operations
  - 2. Reading – 39% average or above
    - a. Lowest performance area: Vocabulary

    - a. Lowest performance area: Geometry
  - 2. Reading – 53% average or above
