### **3. School Profile Sign-Off:**

### **4. COVID Updates**

- a. The district is piloting 'Testing to Stay'
  - i. Arlington is not participating but 5 other elementary schools in Lexington have been chosen
  - ii. Students that have to "quarantine" due to COVID exposure have the opportunity to be COVID tested for 5 consecutive days at school and be held until a rapid COVID test comes back negative (about 45 mins)
  - iii. Arlington's Healthy Kids Clinic is offering COVID testing for students whose parents makes an appointment for it
    - 1. Parents must be present for their child to receive a COVID test at the Healthy Kids Clinic
