1. Opening Business

a. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:18 PM by Mark Rose, Chair.

a. School Schedule

Mr. Rose shared the school schedule for NTI 2-DL with the council. He shared that every student in the school will be operating on the

same schedule. Grade levels will send home schedules with specific schedules noting synchronous (live) and asynchronous (taped) learning times. He said that most specials will not start until October 5. He also shared that a Parent Learning Network will occur on Tuesday evenings from 5-7 where teachers can provide support on what students are learning. He shared that individual grade level schedules will be given to families at the Back to School Nights. It was shared that the day is going to 3:00 because we aren't starting class until 8:45. It was also shared that if we return to the building, elementary students will attend school until 2:45. This is due to the shortened school calendar. The narrative explaining NTI-2DL for ACE was also shared. The council approved the schedule by consensus.

b. Welcoming of New Staff

Mr. Rose shared that we hired a new 4th grade teacher, Shawna Mitchell and a new registrar, Doug Tatters.

c. Fundraisers

Mr. Rose shared that the PTA decided to move forward with the Boosterthon Fun Run. It begins September 9 and the dance will be September 18.

The council elected Marshall Spivey to serve as the ACE representative to participate in the KASC Board of Directors election.
