1. Opening Business

a. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:18 PM by Mark Rose, Chair.

b. Agenda approval

By consensus, the council approved the October 29 agenda.

c. Public Comment

2. New Business/Other Business

a. Targeted Plus Services

Mr. Rose shared a Targeted Services Plus powerpoint with the council. He shared K-Prep (from 2019) and current MAP data of number of students who are below the 50%ile as well as the number of students below the fall mean on MAP.

He shared that Targeted Services Plus will not be new content, but will be review, hands on activities, enrichment, intervention, etc. The purpose of this is also to help transition students back into the school building.

There will be 2 groups of students (Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday) both groups will be from 2:00-4:00. K and 5th grade students will start next week. Assuming everything goes smoothly, 1st and 3rd grade students will start the week of November 9 and 2nd and 4th grade will start the week of November 16. If all students return for targeted services on their set days, ACE will be at 29% of the building capacity on Monday/Tuesday and 27% on Thursday/Friday. Wednesday's will be completely virtual. Targeted

Services PLUS is optional for all students, and teachers will contact families to determine if students are interested in returning.

Discussion occurred around what will happen if the county is in the red. Mr. Rose shared that the district has said as long as there are no more than 15 people in a room, the color of the county will not affect targeted services.

Discussion occurred around ventilation. Mr. Rose shared that the building will operate off of the current ventilation system. He also shared that the filters are regularly changed and teachers can open their windows if they want.

Discussion occurred around teacher schedules since staff will be required to stay until 4:00. Mr. Rose shared that if possible, synchronous virtual classes could be changed to start a little later (9:00).

It was shared that some services such as speech, PT, OT and EL will stay virtual for most services. If parents have concerns with a student's IEP needs being met, they can contact the building ACC (at ACE it is Johnetta Lovell) and it would be helpful if Wednesdays could be more flexible.

Mr. Rose shared that the students are divided into cohort days based upon the IC groupings that the district had created for hybrid learning. Making big changes will not be possible at this time.

If staff are unable to make it to school for targeted services (Covid, other illness, death in family, etc.), families will be notified that the targeted services for the day will be canceled.

It was asked if parents could pick students up early if needed. The answer was yes. However, parents would need to call when they got to school and someone would bring their child out, instead of coming into the building.

In the event of positive Covid cases, only the people who are in contact with the infected person would be quarantined. Families would be notified if this occurred.

For staff who have safety/health concerns about returning in person, they can work with administration for building level accommodations. They can also contact HR/the benefits office for district level accommodations.

K, 1 and 2 will all have plexiglass dividers on the tables.

Ms. Manion motioned to approve the Targeted Services Plus Plan, Mr. Bradley gave a second. The motion passed 6 to 1.

b. January Return to School

Mr. Rose shared that there was no discussion that needed to occur around this at this time as the district hasn't provided enough information.
