1. **Agenda Approval**—Agenda was submitted and reviewed by council. Shayna Langston moved to approve and Robert Wilkison seconded. Approved by consensus.
2. **Minutes Approval**—Minutes from December 2, 2019 were submitted and reviewed by council. Wilkison moved to approve and Langston seconded. Approved by consensus.
3. **Public Comment**—No public.
4. **Financial Reports/MUNIS**—The financial report was reviewed by the council. Sabrina Adkins pointed out that there is still over \$11,000 is carry forward funds that is planning on being spent on new materials, books, and other teaching materials for remainder of this school year and next year.
5. **Amplify Science Purchase**—Last year, Fayette County suggests new curriculum for science called Amplify. The information presented is what the district requests SBDM to review and/or approve. Amplify mainly consist of hands on investigations, engaging lessons, and a proven approach to learning science. Fayette County also tries to have county wide curriculum, so if a student moves to a new school the curriculum will still meet the student’s needs. Professional develop will be provided to all district staff. Amplify has 22 lessons about 30-45 minutes long that are to be taught every day in each classroom. Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade materials by Amplify and presented strong evidence for all four disciplinary core ideas: physical science, life science, earth and space science, and engineering design. The district will be purchasing/providing all materials to implement Amplify. The council approved Amplify by unanimous decision.

6. **CSIP Review**—Adkins quickly reviewed the CSIP. TNTP and weekly PLC's will continue to improve individual students' engagement and learning. Academic indicator and Amplify will start to improve student knowledge through all grades. 5<sup>th</sup> grade is using Simple Solutions to improve Social Studies scores. Achievement gap goal is to increase percentage of African American students scoring by 12%. Growth indicator goal is to increase percentage by 1% and maintain current level of testing/scoring.
