

## **SBDM Meeting--Squires Elementary**

1. **Agenda Approval**—Agenda was submitted and reviewed by council. Robert Wilkerson moved to approve and Amy Sohner seconded. Approved by consensus.
2. **March 1<sup>st</sup> Staffing Allocations**—Before discussing the March 1<sup>st</sup> staffing allocations, Sabrina Adkins moved to two tasks for carry forward form. This form would be filled out to rollover to next school year. The council unanimously approved to rollover over unused carry forward. The second task was to approved ESS (extended school services). ESS would be held for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students who are struggling with their work and/or need additional practice. This program will start on March 11 and last until the end of April. Leftover funds for ESS will be used for LIT camp in the summer. The council approved by consensus.

The council reviewed the district projection options 1 and option 2. Option 1 is similar to what Squires teacher allocations currently has. Option 2 offers a K/1 split. Adkins also shared that Squires could use about \$200,000 of Title 1 monies to allocate in teacher/staff allocation. The staff at Squires also took a survey that gave the administrators an idea of what the staff would prefer to have for the next school year. Adkins suggested five scenarios to the council: the most popular from the staff survey and four other scenarios varying in cost. Upon further discussion, the council unanimously agreed that the “most popular” scenario would be fit the students and finances that Squires will have next year. It is currently the most similar to the staff allocations of 2019-20 school year. It would include the below and would cost \$276,868.

1 Media specialist  
2 Kindergarten assistants  
3 Primary assistants (1 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades)  
2 clerical positions and increasing hours from 35 to 40 hours  
10 extended days for PGES coach  
1 Social Worker
