

## **SBDM Meeting--Squires Elementary**

1. **Agenda Approval**—Agenda was submitted and reviewed by council. Shayna Langston moved to approve and Heidi Thompson-Abell seconded. Approved by consensus.
2. **Summer Ignite**—The Summer Ignite is a district created summer program to aid students and extend learning in preparation for the 2021-2022 school year. Students attending Summer Ignite will be invited based on how they are currently tested in class and for those who are interested. The proposal is due March 19, 2021. There are three sessions available. Sessions 1-2 will be for all current students enrolled in Squires. Session 3 will be for incoming kindergarten students. Expectations are to offer in person learning through rigorous and engaging opportunities. The program will also have social-emotional learning and address the physical well-being of our students. Squires is asking that the district purchase LitCamp Plus (\$15,000), Greg Tang’s Streamlined Curriculum for Math (\$1300), and potential books for incoming kindergarten students (\$1200).

Amy Sohner asked when parents would be finding out if their student is attending the Summer Ignite program. Sabrina Adkins responded that we are currently planning for every child wanting to attend. Langston asked if it was a possibility that we would have to turn away students. Adkins responded that the district wants to provide for as many students as possible. Beth Garner asked, if needed, could we hire staff outside of the school system. Adkins responded that we might have staff from other schools attending our Summer Ignite program to keep the student to teacher ratio 15:1. Garner moved to approve proposal and Abell seconded. Approved by consensus.

3. **Draft Budget**—Adkins briefly reviewed budget for next year which resembled 2020’s budget. Squires is allocated \$39,985 for 2021-2022. Sohner moved to approved Section 6 draft and Langston approved. Approved by consensus.

4. **Staffing**—Title 1 budget will budget and pay for three teachers for 2021-22 school year. Squires will need to pay the workbook about \$10,000 and would pay out of the after school program funds. Langston moved to approve and Abell seconded. Staffing approved by consensus.
5. **Section 6 Carry Forward**—Jessica Price said that we are allowed to carry forward 15% of our current section 6 budget, which is \$6,765. Carry forward allocation for the last 2 years has been around \$18,000 and up. Adkins opened up the floor for ideas to purchase items to help encumber funds from this year. No responses. Any later thoughts should be emailed to Adkins or Price.
