

Graduation cord/sash policy

Adopted April, 2016

A graduation cord/sash may be worn during Paul Laurence Dunbar High School's commencement ceremony if the student is a member of a Fayette County district established program or nationally recognized academic honor organization/program. Each organization's sponsor will utilize their group's established membership and graduation requirements to determine a student's eligibility to receive the cord/sash, as well as indicate the specific cord/sash to be worn during the ceremony. The wearing of a cultural and/or religious cord/sash will need to be approved by administration four weeks prior to graduation.
