

PTA Meeting Minutes

1. Meeting called to order at 5:04 pm
2. Approve meeting minutes from 2/18/20
 - a. Motion to approve the minutes by Waneta Padgett
 - b. Seconded by Futrell
 - c. All in favor
 - d. Motion passed unanimously and the minutes were approved
3. Fundraiser results
 - a. We just got those results today the fundraiser made \$3,993.67. 40% of that will be ours to keep.
 - b. All agree that it was fairly easy to do and went well overall.
 - c. If anyone has kids that did not get their prize please let April know
4. Spring Carnival
 - a. April's schedule is so slammed that she does not want to do a spring carnival and instead wants to do something during field day
 - b. Branch points out that the Spring season is a busy time for us. She notes the two title one days coming up as well as the MAP window, KPREP, conference night, etc.
 - c. Per Asher the PTA can bring in things for field day.
 - d. April suggests inflatables
 - e. Waneta notes that previously they did snow cones and last year they did popsicles.
 - f. Teachers like the idea of a popsicle or snow cones
 - g. Asher suggests splitting the cost of the inflatables between the PTA and the school. Waneta notes that the PTA only did one fundraiser this year so the PTA may have less to contribute.
 - h. Fletcher notes that Tribble had a connection for a cheaper price on inflatables.
 - i. Byers suggests 3/27 for a glow party. Asher said she will get back with her because bulldog bash is that day. The glow party will be around 30 minutes with all primary and intermediate students grouped together.
 - j. Padgett notes that popsicles are better for the budget. Futrell notes that as a classroom teacher it is easy to do popsicles and not necessarily special. Teachers would prefer snow cones. Padgett and Byers will text Nikkisha to discuss the budget regarding snow cones and inflatables. 27th will be K and 5th grade recognition. Field day will be the 28th as of right now. As of now Byers is not sure if they will be able to support promotion days financially. Byers is going to email Chip to ask. Asher says she'd prefer the PTA to do the right thing and the school will cover if needed.
 - k. Byers brings up that Branch wants costumes for her arts and humanities requests. The PTA will take teacher requests but they must fill out a form.
 - i. Branch asks where the form is. No one knows.
 - ii. Byers says she will find it for her.
 - l. Padgett suggests that the PTA may be able to cover the entire cost of the inflatables to offset the loss of paying for the recognition days.
 - m. Branch suggests that Byers get dates together for next year to put on the master calendar for next year. These dates should be gathered by May.
 - n. Byers states she wants to support the school in other ways: e.g. supplies.
 - o. Byers spoke to Ms. Baker in the front office regarding teacher appreciation week.

- p. Futrell suggests a fun run where each child gets paid for each lap they run. She suggests this to fundraise for a long-term goal.
