A motion was made at 5:02 p.m. to begin the meeting by Mr. Popplewell and was seconded by Dr. Verdecchia and was found favorable.

**1. Approval of Agenda:** A motion was made to approve the agenda by Ms. George and was seconded by Ms. Nathaniel and was found favorable.

**2. Approval of Minutes:** A motion was made to approve the minutes by Ms. Tracy and seconded by Ms. Clay and was found favorable.

**3. Public Comments:** there were none.

**4. Good News:** Mr. Hale presented the good news to the council.

**5. Digital SBDM Notebook:** Ms. Marcum presented the google site to the council about the changes for the school year.

Ms. Marcum also presented and explained the required KRS statutes and documents, Managing Government Records and Your Duty Under The Law and will send out the document to have each council member sign off.

Canvas will be utilized this fall by the staff and students for a blended learning environment. Ms. Eppley presented to the council about how it looks, the things that have been created for teachers, non negotiables for the content, etc.

**9. Principals Report:** Mr. Hale reported to the council about the Modern Classroom project that several of our staff will be participating in this fall to learn more about a blended learning approach.
